# Waddill Mistrial: 7-5 Deadlocked

## Jurors Say They Were Split from Start

SANTA ANA — Almost from the very beginning of their 11 days of deliberations, the jury in the Dr. William Waddill baby murder trial was hopelessly deadlocked.

Yesterday after the jurors were dismissed, they recalled that on their first ballot, two had voted guilty, three not guilty and seven undecided.

By the eighth day, three jurors were still holding out for acquittal of the 42-year-old Orange County obstetrician accused of strangling — or letting die —

an infant survivor of a saline abortion. The abortion itself was not at issue, jurors said, after Turner instructed them that the operation had been per-

formed and the defendant on those grounds.

"We felt there wasn't enough evidence," said Kathie Davis, the 22-year-old

America today, that the sun is god or the sun is the center of the universe. A bunch believe that the sun is all there is.

Q: What convinces you the earth is flat rather than, say, a cube or square?

DIEGO (AP) — An ear in the Gulf of California Southern California yesterday measured 5.5 on the scale. There were no signs of damage or injury. A spokesman for the California Institute of Technology in Pasadena measured 5.5 on the scale. A reading that could cause severe damage if it hit a populated area. The quake's epicenter was off the coast, 70 miles west of the Mexican border.
